Update on Bylaws

In reviewing our governing documents and our minutes from the past few years, our Constitution and Policy Planning Committee discovered an error in which By Laws II, III, IV, V, VI, and VII were erroneously amended on February 25, 2019 in a way that violated our Constitution. Because of this, the By Laws on our website are invalid and not the correct versions. We are currently in the process of rectifying this error and we will be creating a policy to ensure that a similar error cannot happen in the future. However, in the name of transparency and openness, we wanted to give an update to the student body to inform you of what is going on within the MSVUSU.
